SIMPLIFIED JUMP HEIGHT CARD PROCESS

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the "Dogs to Be Measured" list. ***It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.***

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on a dirt surface. Ring size will be 106' x 88'. **Equipment for this trial supplied by MAX200. MAX200 will also have equipment available for sale.**

Preliminary Confirmations: A preliminary confirmation will be emailed, please double check all information and report any errors to the Trial Secretary as soon as possible.

If you do not include an email address and would like to know the status of your entry prior to closing, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard along with your entry.

Final Confirmations: E-mail confirmations and judging schedules will be sent to those listing a legible e-mail address on the entry form. If you would like a mailed copy of the final confirmation and judging schedule, **PLEASE** include a self addressed stamped envelope with your entry.

Armbands will not be mailed – please pick them up at the trial when you arrive.

No hand deliveries for the first 24 hours.

Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Joy DeSipio at jdesipiotrialsec@verizon.net. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A charge of \$25 will be made for each returned check. No online entries.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From the North via Route 113S:

Take Rt 113S /Rt 1S to Frederica. Turn right onto Rt 12. Follow Rt 12 through Frederica. Rt 12 will turn right in Frederica onto E Front St. Follow Rt 12 approximately 2.7 miles. Turn right onto Robbins. The site is on the right.

From the South via Route 113N:

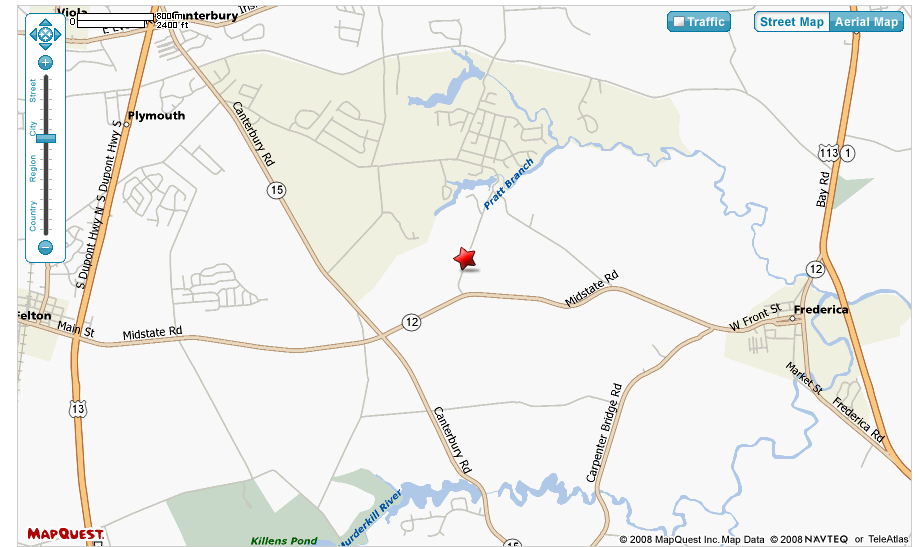
Take Rt 113N to Frederica. Turn left onto Frederica Rd. Turn right to remain on Frederica Rd. Turn left on E Front St (Rt 12W) and follow for 2.7 miles. Turn right on Robbins Rd. The site is on the right.

From the South via Route 13N:

Take Rt 13N to Felton. Turn right turn onto Midstate Rd (Rt 12). Go approximately 3 miles. Turn left onto Robbins. The site is on the right.

From the West (Bay Bridge):

Take Rt 50/301 East. Merge on to US 50 East. Turn left onto 404. Go North on MD 313. Turn right onto MD 317. MD 317 changes to DE 14 in Delaware. Follow DE 14 through Harrington to Rt 13. Turn left onto Rt 13. Follow direction from the South via Rt 13N.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

As of September 1, 2010 the AKC allows clubs to maintain a waitlist that enables exhibitors to be accepted into the trial after closing date provided the entry was received prior to closing and another exhibitor pulls from the trial creating an opening for the waitlisted exhibitor. The club must also notify exhibitors of the "Waitlist Closing Date". This waitlist closing is the time frame in which an exhibitor must be notified that he or she is now in the trial. ***ALL ENTRIES MUST STILL BE RECEIVED BY THE TRIAL SECRETARY ON OR BEFORE THE TRIAL CLOSING DATE OF AUGUST 31, 2010 at 6:00p.m. TO BE CONSIDERED ELIGIBLE.***

BHAD will be maintaining a waitlist compiled of a maximum twenty (20) exhibitors. All exhibitors who do not make it into the trial on "first received" rules will be notified of their placement on the waitlist. If an exhibitor chooses to remain on the waitlist he or she will be notified no later than Monday September 13, 2010 at 6:00p.m. of their entry's acceptance into the trial.

Please Note: This waitlist rule is only in effect if the trial fills our maximum runs of 330 per day.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. BHAD and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. BHAD reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the BHAD or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. Use of FLEXI-LEADS is NOT permitted in the trial building or near the building doors (you may use them to potty your dogs outside the trial building).

REFUNDS

Entry fees will NOT be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Refunds will be given (less a processing fee of \$10.00 per day) for bitches in season or dogs injured after closing. Written notification, including a Veterinarian's letter, must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than 6PM Monday, September 20, 2010.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging, if a valid copy of their jump height card was sent with their entry. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crating space will be available. The Trial site has a dirt floor, please bring appropriate tarps. Setup on Friday night from 6:00pm to 8:00pm. Site opens Saturday at 7:00am. Blue Heron Agility Association of Delaware and the Heartland Equestrian will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Food will be available on site.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776.
